	Santa Anna is captured and Texas Gains its independence.
Massacre at Goliad	After Colonel Fannin surrendered his 400 men at the Battle of Coleto Creek, Santa Anna ordered they be marched out on the road and executed near Goliad.
Battle of Gonzales 1	Began because Texans refused to give up the cannon. This battle showed that Texans would fight for their rights and independence.
